Ebenezer Cemetery Association Rules and Provisions

Ebenezer Cemetery Association

Will arrange for placement of corner lot markers upon sale of lots.

Make necessary arrangements to open/close graves for funerals.

Provide perpetual care of the cemetery that includes grass cutting and general maintenance.

Rules Governing Lot Owners

Railings/fencing around the gravesite are not permitted.

Planting flowers, shrubs, trees on or near a gravesite is not permitted.

Flowers placed on gravesites for funerals will be removed when they become unattractive, unusually within two weeks following the funeral. Flowers for special occasions should be removed in a reasonable time following the event. Seasonal decorations for Christmas should be removed by January 31, while Easter flowers are permitted until grass cutting time. The Cemetery Association reserves the right to discard flowers left beyond these dates. The Cemetery Association is not responsible for stolen or lost decorations. Please keep all other decorations to a minimum so as not to obstruct ground maintenance. Please keep grass clear or corner markers for ready identification.

Vaults are required for burials with caskets. Burials are limited to two pre-sites: one burial with casket and one cremation or two cremations. (No two deep burials with caskets).

Gravesites should be marked with a monument within one year of the funeral.

Above ground Monuments for double graves cannot exceed four feet wide by four feet high by four feet in depth. (4 x 4 x 4). Maximum width for monuments for a single grave with granite markers would be 36 inches while max width for graves with metal markers would be 34 inches. Monuments are the property of lot owners and must be cared for and maintained by the owner. The Cemetery Association assumes no responsibility for them. The Cemetery Association may find it necessary to repair/secure monuments to prevent damage. Such repairs will be billed to owners or known relatives. Above ground monuments are not permitted in Section D as specified by the benefactor of the parcel Graves in this area marked by flat markers only. The maximum width for single grave sites with granite corner markers would be 30 inches with metal markers maximum would be 28 inches. Grave sites in our cremation area will only accommodate 12 x 24 inches markers.

Visitors in the Cemetery are expected to be respectful to preserve a quiet place to honor loved ones. Visitations are limited to daylight hours. No other activities are permitted on the grounds including driving.

Lot owners are not permitted to see or transfer lots with permission of the Cemetery Association. The Association reserves the right to repurchase lots at the original purchase price.
