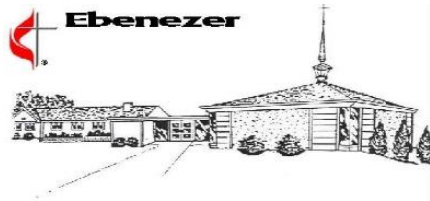
Jelly Jars needed for VBS
